All Questions are Based on a LIKERT approach.

All options carry different weightage (on a scale of 1 to 4 , where 4 marks represent the most appropriate option and 1 mark represents the least appropriate answer)

1. You're part of a group preparing for a debate competition. Some members of the group talk a lot during practice, leaving little chance for others to speak. What would you do?
(tests Entrepreneurship mindset skills)
 - (A) Talk to the members who talk a lot, telling them it's important for everyone to have a chance to speak. (3)
 - (B) Stay quiet during practice because you don't want to argue, but you feel unhappy because you don't get to talk. (1)
 - (C) Suggest having a plan for practice where everyone gets a turn to speak, so it's fair. (4)
 - (D) Practice separately with other members who don't talk as much, so you can all improve together. (2)
2. You receive Rs. 5000 as a scholarship from being the topper in your school olympiad . How would you decide what to do with the money? (tests Financial Literacy Skills)
 - (A) Keep a part of it as savings and Invest the rest in parent's stocks or mutual funds to potentially earn more money in the future. (4)
 - (B) Deposit it in a savings account at a bank to earn interest over time. (3)
 - (C) Spend it on useless items like fancy toys (1)
 - (D) Keep it as cash in your wallet for emergencies or future spending. (2)
3. You're in a debate and have to argue for a side you don't agree with. How do you handle it?
(tests Emotional Intelligence)
 - (A) Argue for the side you were given, even if you don't agree, and focus on doing your best while ignoring your personal beliefs. (2)
 - (B) Decide not to join the debate because you don't want to defend a view you disagree with. (1)
 - (C) Research both sides to understand them better, even if it makes you uncomfortable. (4)
 - (D) Talk to others open - mindedly to learn more about the topic and question your own beliefs. (3)
4. You've been asked to design a new pen for your school. What features do you think are most important? (tests Design Thinking and Innovation)
 - (A) A pen with a comfortable grip but ink that smudges easily. (1)
 - (B) A pen with smooth ink flow but the pen keeps falling from the table.(3)
 - (C) A pen with multiple ink colors but a bulky design that's difficult to hold. (2)
 - (D) A pen with a sleek design, comfortable grip, and quick-drying ink. (4)
